Deep within the heart of the English countryside, yet easily accessible from the M6 and the M54, lies Hawkstone Park. BY ROAD

From the M6 southbound, junction 15

Exit junction 15 and get into the right-hand lane. Pass through the traffic lights and follow signs for A53 Shrewsbury. Turn right at next lights, following the A53 past Loggerheads, Market Drayton and the roundabout with the A41 (petrol station on the right). Exit A53 at next roundabout, signed Hawkstone Park, Historic Follies and Golf Course and follow these signs to Weston. Turn right at the village's triangular green to Hawkstone Park.

From the M6 northbound, junction 10a

Exit onto M54. Continue as M54 directions below.

From the M6 Toll, junction T8

Follow the A460 south, joining the M54. Continue as M54 directions below.

From the M54

At the end of the M54 continue on the A5 to Shrewsbury. Turn right at the roundabout onto the A49 towards Whitchurch. Stay on the A49 for 10 miles, then following the A49 directions below.

From the A49

Exit the A49 following signs for Hawkstone Park, Historic Follies and Golf Course. This is a right turn if travelling from Shrewsbury, a left turn from Whitchurch.
